Jimmie Patsey, 94, of Coalwood, WV, passed away Wednesday, May 24, 2023 at the Golden Harvest Section of Welch Community Hospital in Welch. Born June 15, 1928 in Premier, WV, he was the son of the late Philip (Pizzato) Patsey and Maria Nicki Patsey.
