NANCY LEE STOVER

Nancy Lee (Mullins) Stover, 83, of Parkersburg (formerly of Welch, WV), passed into her Savior's arms on May 10, 2022 at Roanoke Memorial Hospital. She was born December 13, 1938 in Big Jenny, WV to the late Roby and Mae Deel Mullins.

Nancy graduated from Pineville High School in 1956. In August 1958, she married Charles Stover and their union produced a daughter, Rhonda Stover, and a son, Gary (Lisa) Stover, both of Parkersburg, WV. She was a loving mother who always put the needs of her children first.

Nancy spent the bulk of her adult years in Welch, owning a small business for a number of years and then retiring after working for the state of WV for several years. Her customers at The Fabric Shop became like family to her. Nancy never met a stranger and loved talking to people. Most of all, she enjoyed sharing the love of Christ with all whose path she crossed. Her compassion, generosity, and service were known throughout the community. An untold number of lives were touched and changed for the better for having known her.
